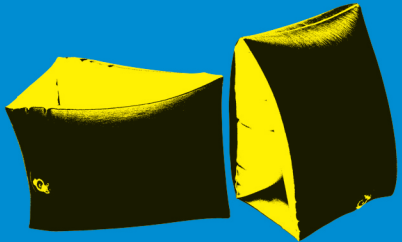

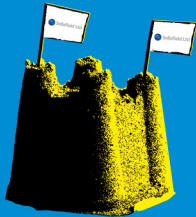
Where we're based

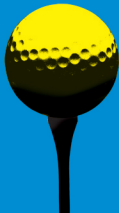
Extraordinary
