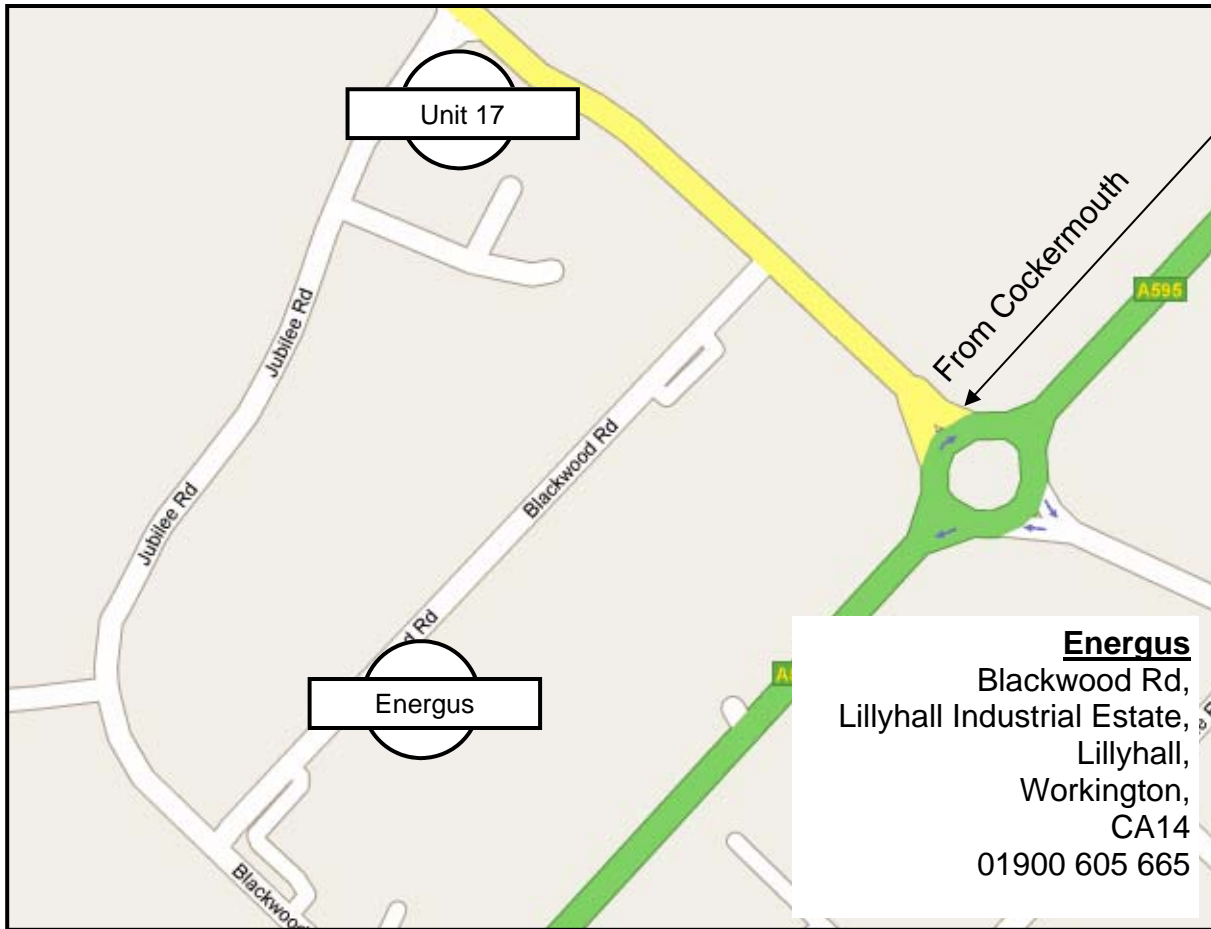
The launch will provide an opportunity to learn more about the plan and how it is already being used to guide Nuclear Management Partner's community investment and our vision for its
