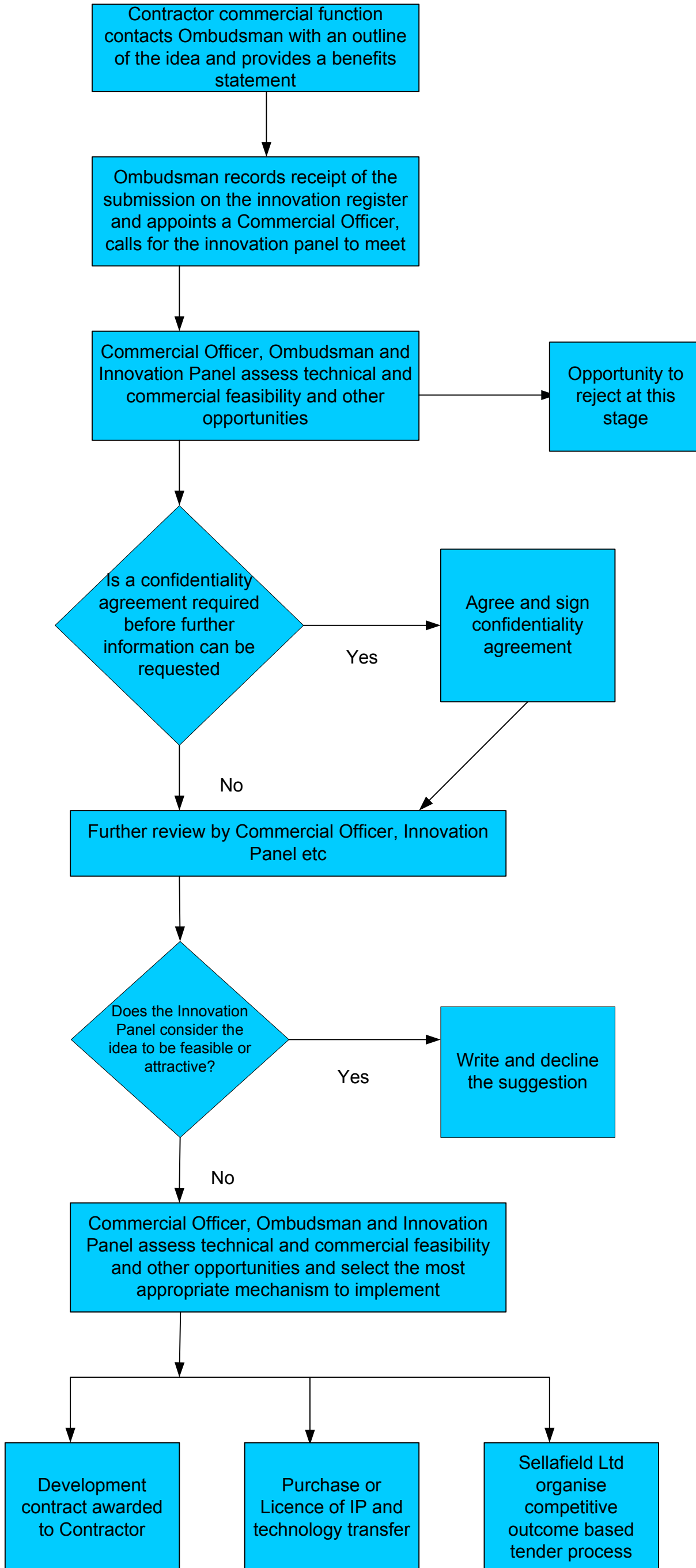


SPECULATIVE SUGGESTION PROCESS



The high level outline should describe the innovation in sufficient detail to enable the concept to be demonstrated and the potential benefits assessed whilst minimising the release of information the contractor considers to be proprietary

The contractor should outline any Intellectual Property that he owns or has rights to

At this point the contractor may divulge information that he considers proprietary

Contractor to present the idea if appropriate to the Innovation Panel. This is to include proposals for ownership and rights to background and foreground Intellectual Property. An assessment of business benefit may be required

Will agree appropriate terms of ownership and use of background and foreground Intellectual Property for

- a) one specific contract
- or
- b) for wider use
